Reciting the **108 names of Lakshmi** (Lakṣmī Aṣṭottara Śatanāmāvaliḥ) is a sacred practice believed to attract blessings, peace, and prosperity in every aspect of life. These names, drawn from ancient scriptures, reflect her various forms such as Dhana Lakṣmī, Dhairya Lakṣmī, Gaja Lakṣmī, and more.

Salutations to the Goddess of Nature
Prakṛti represents the natural world, the primal energy, and the fundamental nature of the universe. Lakshmi as Prakṛti signifies her role as the source and sustainer of creation.
2. ॐ विकृत्यै नमः
om vikṛtyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of Transformation
Vikṛti refers to change or transformation. This name highlights Lakshmi's power to transform and bring about change in the universe and in the lives of her devotees.
3. ॐ विद्यायै नमः
om vidyāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of Knowledge
Vidyā means knowledge or wisdom. Lakshmi as Vidyā embodies the wisdom and understanding that enlightens and guides individuals on their spiritual and material journeys.
4. ॐ सर्वभूतहितप्रदायै नमः
om sarvabhūtahitapradāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Benefactress of All Beings
This name signifies Lakshmi's benevolent nature, providing welfare and prosperity to all living creatures, ensuring their well-being and happiness.
5. ॐ श्रद्धायै नमः
om śraddhāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of Faith
Śraddhā represents faith and devotion. Lakshmi as Śraddhā inspires faith and trust, essential for spiritual growth and success in life.
6. ॐ विभूत्यै नमः
om vibhūtyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of Wealth and Glory
Vibhūti signifies wealth, prosperity, and divine glory. Lakshmi as Vibhūti bestows material and spiritual riches upon her devotees.
7. ॐ सुरभ्यै नमः
om surabhyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of Fragrance
Surabhi means fragrance or pleasantness. Lakshmi as Surabhi brings an aura of divine fragrance and positivity, enriching life with beauty and grace.

om paramātmikāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Supreme Soul
Paramātmikā refers to the supreme soul or ultimate reality. This name of Lakshmi highlights her divine essence as the ultimate source and sustainer of all creation.

om vāce namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of Speech
Vāc means speech or voice. Lakshmi as Vāc signifies her role in providing eloquence and wisdom, empowering communication that is truthful and enlightening.

om padmālayāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the One Who Resides in the Lotus

Padmālaya means residing in a lotus. This name alludes to Lakshmi's purity and divinity, as the lotus is a symbol of spiritual enlightenment and beauty.

om padmāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Lotus Goddess

Padmā signifies the lotus, which is a symbol of purity, beauty, and transcendence. Lakshmi as Padmā embodies these qualities, bringing prosperity and spiritual growth.

om śucaye namaḥ

Salutations to the Pure One

Śuci means pure or clean. Lakshmi as Śuci represents purity of thought, action, and spirit, guiding devotees towards a life of integrity and virtue.

Salutations to the Goddess of Offerings

Svāhā is the mantra used in offerings to the fire during rituals. Lakshmi as Svāhā represents the divine acceptance of offerings and the blessings that follow.

om svadhāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Goddess of Oblations

Svadhā refers to the offerings made to ancestors. Lakshmi as Svadhā honors the connection to one's lineage and the blessings of the forebears.

om sudhāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Goddess of Nectar

Sudhā means nectar or ambrosia, symbolizing immortality and divine bliss. Lakshmi as Sudhā brings the nectar of spiritual wisdom and eternal joy.

om dhanyāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Blessed One

Dhanyā signifies being blessed or fortunate. Lakshmi as Dhanyā bestows blessings and fortune, enriching the lives of her devotees with abundance and grace.

Salutations to the Golden One

Salutations to the Goddess of Wealth

Lakṣmī is the goddess of wealth, fortune, and prosperity. As Lakṣmī, she embodies abundance in all forms, both material and spiritual.

om nityapuṣṭāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Ever-Nourishing One

Nityapuṣṭā means eternally nourished or flourishing. Lakshmi as Nityapuṣṭā ensures continuous growth and sustenance, providing nourishment to all aspects of life.

Salutations to the Goddess of the Night

Vibhāvarī means night or the one who illuminates the night. Lakshmi as Vibhāvarī brings light and clarity, dispelling darkness and ignorance.

Salutations to the Mother of the Gods

Aditya refers to the mother of the Ādityas, the solar deities, symbolizing brilliance and nurturing energy.

Ditye signifies the one who provides light, a reference to the luminous and enlightening nature of the goddess.

Dīpā implies radiance and illumination, representing Lakshmi's ability to dispel darkness and ignorance.

Vasudhā means Earth, highlighting Lakshmi's role as the provider of wealth and sustenance, akin to Mother Earth.

Salutations to the Bearer of the Earth

Vasudhāriṇī signifies the one who holds and nurtures the Earth, symbolizing stability and prosperity.

Salutations to the Lotus Goddess

Kamalā refers to the lotus, a symbol of purity, beauty, and spiritual enlightenment, often associated with Lakshmi.

Salutations to the Beloved

Kāntā means beloved or beautiful, emphasizing Lakshmi's enchanting and attractive nature.

Kāmākṣī signifies having eyes that fulfill desires, representing her ability to grant wishes and bring fulfillment.

Salutations to the One Born of Anger

Krodhasambhavā indicates a form of the goddess that arises to subdue negativity and restore balance.

Salutations to the Bestower of Grace

Anugrahapradā signifies the goddess's role in granting blessings and divine grace to her devotees.

Salutations to the One Who is Wisdom

Buddhi represents wisdom and intelligence, attributes that Lakshmi embodies and bestows upon her followers.

32. ॐ अनघायै नमः

om anaghāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Sinless One

Anaghā means pure and free from sin, highlighting the goddess's purity and moral perfection.

33. ॐ हरिवल्लभायै नमः

om harivallabhāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Beloved of Hari

Harivallabhā signifies Lakshmi as the beloved consort of Lord Vishnu (Hari), representing divine partnership and harmony.

34. ॐ अशोकायै नमः

om aśokāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the One Who is Free from Sorrow

Aśokā signifies freedom from grief and sorrow, representing Lakshmi's role in bringing joy and eliminating distress.

35. ॐ अमृतायै नमः

om amṛtāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the Immortal One

Amṛtā means immortal or eternal, symbolizing the goddess's timeless and everlasting nature.

Salutations to the Shining One

Dīptā indicates brilliance and radiance, emphasizing Lakshmi's luminous presence and divine light.

Salutations to the Destroyer of Worldly Sorrows

Salutations to the Compassionate One

Lakshmi is often depicted holding lotuses, representing prosperity and divine grace.

Salutations to She whose eyes are like lotuses

Lotus-like eyes symbolize beauty, compassion, and serenity.

Salutations to the beautiful one like a lotus

This name emphasizes Lakshmi's unparalleled beauty and divine charm.

om padmodbhavāyai namaḥ

Salutations to She who emerged from a lotus

Lakshmi is believed to have emerged from the ocean on a lotus during the churning of the ocean.

46. ॐ पद्ममुख्यै नमः

om padmamukhyai namaḥ

Salutations to She whose face is like a lotus

Her face is compared to a lotus, symbolizing purity and tranquility.

47. ॐ पद्मनाभप्रियायै नमः

om padmanābhapriyāyai namaḥ

Salutations to the beloved of Padmanabha (Vishnu)

Padmanabha, meaning 'lotus-navel', is a name for Vishnu, highlighting Lakshmi's connection to him.

48. ॐ रमायै नमः

om ramāyai namaḥ

Salutations to Ramā

Ramā is another name for Lakshmi, denoting her as the goddess of prosperity and happiness.

Salutations to She who wears a garland of lotuses

The garland of lotuses represents purity, spiritual enlightenment, and divine beauty.

Fragrance symbolizes the spread of divine grace and purity.

om candrasahodaryai namaḥ

Salutations to She who is the sister of the moon

This name highlights her celestial connection and divine family lineage.

60. ॐ चतुर्भुजायै नमः

om caturbhujāyai namaḥ

Salutations to She who has four arms

The four arms of Lakshmi symbolize her divine power and ability to bestow blessings in all directions.

61. ॐ चन्द्ररूपायै नमः

om candrarūpāyai namaḥ

Salutations to Her who has the form of the moon

This name signifies Lakshmi's serene and calming nature, reflecting the soothing presence of the moon.

62. ॐ इन्दिरायै नमः

om indirāyai namaḥ

Salutations to Indira

Indira is another name for Lakshmi, symbolizing beauty, splendor, and prosperity.

This name refers to Lakshmi as the one who removes poverty and bestows prosperity and abundance upon her devotees.

102. ॐ देव्यै नमः
oṃ devyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess
This is a general invocation to the Goddess, acknowledging her divine and supreme nature.
103. ॐ सर्वोपद्रव वारिण्यै नमः
oṃ sarvopadrava vāriṇyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Remover of All Disturbances
This name signifies Lakshmi's power to eliminate all troubles and disturbances, bringing peace and harmony.
104. ॐ नवदुर्गायै नमः
oṃ navadurgāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Nine Forms of Durga
This name connects Lakshmi to the nine forms of Durga, symbolizing her strength and protective qualities.
105. ॐ महाकाल्यै नमः
oṃ mahākālyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Great Kali
This name associates Lakshmi with Mahakali, representing her fierce and transformative aspects.
106. ॐ ब्रह्माविष्णुशिवात्मिकायै नमः
oṃ brahmāviṣṇuśivātmikāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Essence of Brahma, Vishnu, and Shiva
This name highlights Lakshmi's embodiment of the energies of the three principal deities of Hinduism, symbolizing creation, preservation, and destruction.
107. ॐ त्रिकालज्ञानसंपन्नायै नमः
oṃ trikāla-jñāna-sampannāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the One Endowed with Knowledge of the Three Times
This refers to Lakshmi's wisdom and insight into the past, present, and future, signifying her omniscience.
108. ॐ भुवनेश्वर्यै नमः
oṃ bhuvaneśvāyai namaḥ
Salutations to the Goddess of the Universe
This name venerates Lakshmi as the supreme ruler and protector of the universe, emphasizing her divine authority.

॥ इति श्रीलक्ष्म्यष्टोत्तरशत नामावलिः ॥
|| iti śrīlakṣmyaṣṭottaraśata nāmāvaliḥ ||
